To: Chair Richard Carlbom, Minnesota DFL, and fellow DFL officers

Dear Chair Carlbom,

Our campaign writes today to request a formal investigation into a series of antisemitic incidents that have occurred during organizing unit conventions within the DFL as well as incidents targeting members of our staff.

On March 24 at 7:15 A.M. CT, a campaign staffer received a phone call from an anonymous blocked number – believed to be a delegate – who called the staffer a “*kike bitch*” and further said “*Angie Craig takes dirty Jewish money and only the kikes in St. Louis Park support her.*”

In addition, on March 28 at the Senate District 55 convention, a delegate said, “*I believe we should cut off all aid to Israel. I honestly think we should nuke them.*” This same delegate went on to say that “*We should round up all rich people and just shoot them.*” and “*I don’t believe Luigi Mangione did anything wrong.*” He was not removed from the convention, despite police being notified of his potential security risks.

Our campaign believes these incidents should be investigated promptly and that the DFL should take appropriate action and make clear that antisemitism in addition to other forms of hate will not be tolerated in our party. As our campaign and the Congresswoman have expressed many times: violence and the threat of violence have no place in our politics and no place in our party.

Our campaign condemns this behavior in the strongest possible terms, along with all forms of hate, bigotry, and intimidation. Our campaign remains committed to moving the DFL and the state of Minnesota forward – and that commitment includes holding our own party accountable. Hate in all forms must be called out, whether it comes from the right or the left.

We hope this serves as a necessary wake-up call for the DFL. We urge prompt and decisive action – action that allows the DFL to live up to our shared goal of building a big-tent party rooted in the principles of respect, dignity, and integrity.
